


It is the LORD who keeps faith for ever, who is just to those who are oppressed. It is God who gives bread to the hungry, God, who sets prisoners free; **R/.**

HOMILY

NICENE CREED


THE LORD'S PRAYER


Do not be afraid. I have told you I will come back to you; have faith in me. R/.
