

Pray, brothers and sisters, that my sacrifice and yours may be acceptable to God, the almighty Father.


R/. May the Lord accept the sacrifice at your hands for the praise and glory of God's name, for our good and the good of all God's holy Church.

Lift up your hearts. **R/.** We lift them up to the Lord.





THE LORD'S PRAYER






