# The Pastor's Corner

May 19, 2024



Dear Parishioners and Friends,

In today's second reading for Pentecost Sunday, we hear these words from St. Paul, written to the Christians in Corinth: "There are different kinds of spiritual gifts but the same Spirit; there are different forms of service but the same Lord; there are different workings but the same God who produces all of them in everyone. To each individual the manifestation of the Spirit is given for some benefit."

This parish community of St. Patrick-St. Anthony very definitely embodies Paul's message! We bring our spiritual gifts, different forms of service and works, and we use them for the benefit of others. Whether it be our ministry at Sunday liturgies or our daily endeavors to feed the hungry, we are a people endowed by the Holy Spirit to serve one another with dedication and commitment. "For in one Spirit we were all baptized into one body."

In a few weeks, our parish will be enriched by our program "Source and Summit, Sacrifice and Supper: The Meaning of the Eucharist." All that we do for one another, empowered by the Holy Spirit given to us at Baptism, comes from the Eucharist – the source and summit of our Christian life.

But first, let us take a few moments to remember that all of this is possible through the power of the Holy Spirit. The Great Doxology which concludes the Eucharistic Prayer says it best: "Through him, and with him and in him, O God, almighty Father, *in the unity of the Holy Spirit*, all glory and power is yours, for ever and ever. Amen."

All that we are and all that we do are a result of the Holy Spirit having come upon us and imbuing us with a power that often goes under-appreciated, or worse, under-used! It took me a long time to come to appreciate the remarkable gift that the Holy Spirit is to the Church and to each baptized Christian. Let's not let the gift lie unused!

## Sister Parish Update

The situation in Haiti remains unstable, violent and lawless, especially in and around the capital city, Port-au-Prince. Our Sister Parish, St. Genevieve and its school are located in Z'Orange, 16 miles north of the city.

But hopeful events are still happening amid this seeming chaos.

The St. Genevieve School is open, and the students are taking



their examinations. We're going to share the results with you when Fr. Gaby is able to send them. The principal, teachers and staff remain faithful to their

teaching mission, and have sent appreciation of the increased salaries our generous community support has provided them.

Also, our parish's steadfast support is providing students a hot meal and allowing them to keep up with their education in a safe space to learn and study, even in this environment of dramatic food inflation and lack of availability.



Fr. Gaby reports that he is still a target of gang violence and so is unfortunately still unable to return to live with his parishioners.

The Sister Parish committee members are grateful for your continued prayers and donations for our Sister Parish as we all pray for the success of plans to establish an interim governing body that might lend stability, and bring an end to the gang violence in this beleaguered country.

## **HOW TO REPORT AN INCIDENT OF SEXUAL ABUSE TO THE ARCHDIOCESE OF HARTFORD**

If you have knowledge or suspect that a minor or vulnerable adult (an adult with an intellectual disability) has been sexually abused, in any manner, by personnel of the Archdiocese of Hartford, you are urged to report this information to:

In addition, you will be asked to follow up in writing with a detailed description of the facts involved in the incident. Specifics of this written report can be found in the [Policies and Procedures of the Archdiocese of Hartford Relating to Allegations of Sexual Misconduct Involving Minors and Vulnerable Adults](#). This document is also available online at [www.archdioceseofhartford.org](http://www.archdioceseofhartford.org). The Archdiocese of Hartford will report any and all incidents to the proper civil authorities.

Mandated reporters in the State of Connecticut are required by law to report any incident of sexual abuse involving a minor or vulnerable adult. We encourage any Non-Mandated persons to report such incidents to the proper authorities as well. We support your right to do so.

Department of Social Services for the Elderly

Once a written report of an incident of sexual abuse of a minor or vulnerable adult has been received, an investigation will be undertaken by, or on behalf of, the Archdiocese of Hartford.
