On Sunday, June 30, our parish will initiate its annual and only fund-raising campaign, "Christmas in July," to support our more than 20-year covenant between our parish and the St. Genevieve parish and school in Haiti. The "Christmas in July" campaign reminds us in the middle of the year what the birth of Jesus stands for back in December. In another way, it is an opportunity for us to "recharge our spiritual and charitable batteries."

We are all aware of the intolerable social and political turmoil in Haiti. Despite these horrible conditions, our continued support through our "Christmas in July" campaign brings much-needed



economic, social, and personal relief from the threats of violence and economic hardship. Most importantly our contributions sustain our mutual hope for eventual peace.

We can sustain this goal by con-

tinuing to support the education of of 400 children, provide a high protein lunch for the children, and financial support for teacher salaries with appreciation for their continued service during a very difficult time. Father Gabby uses any remaining funds to support some very impoverished and elderly parishioners who have no other means to survive. In addition to these efforts, we recently learned that the basic medical services available to St. Genevieve

families are threatened by loss of staff and funding formerly provided by other U.S. parishes. We would like to explore with Father Gabby how we can help to fill this gap to provide families with access to vaccinations and other very basic medical care.

As a parish community, we do all this and fight against the inhumanity and terror experienced by our St. Genevieve families. May their hearts in Haiti continue to hope in God's love.



Our June book selection is *The Heaven & Earth Grocery Store* by James McBride.





### Pasta Tuesdays and Warm Dinner Thursdays

Happy 1st Anniversary everyone! We just completed our one year anniversary of SPSA prepared "to go" meals on Tuesdays and

Thursdays thanks to the many hands that prepare the food, provide supplies and help package and serve each Tuesday and Thursday. We started out serving 30 -40 meals each night, over the past several weeks that number has remained in the high 80s. We cannot express strongly enough how happy and thankful people are to receive the meals. We are going through 8 - 10 lbs of baked pasta each Tuesday.

On Thursdays we work with Corporate lunch leftovers that come our way and supplement those with rice or pasta or meat. For the summer months we are planning on continuing with baked pasta for Tuesdays and we will do a cold pasta salad with chicken or meatballs or tacos on Thursdays.

#### How can you get involved?

Pasta Tuesday: We are always in need of one pound trays of baked pasta - ziti, meat sauce and pasta, creamy chicken and broccoli - your choice. Baked pasta dishes can be frozen so if you prefer to deliver after your favorite Sunday mass that is always an option or any time before 2 pm on Tuesdays.
