It is not true that this world and its people are intended to live with violence and war. But this is true: I have come that they may have life in abundance. **Response: God of peace, teach us your ways.**

It is not true that we must accept inhumanity and discrimination, hunger and poverty, war and violence as the norm.

But this is true: the deaf hear, the dead are raised to life, the poor hear the good news. *Response: God of peace, teach us your ways.*

It is not true that violence and hatred have the last word, and that war and destruction will stay forever. But this is true: death shall be no more, neither shall there be mourning or crying or pain anymore.

Response: God of peace, teach us your ways.

It is not true that our dreams of human dignity, of mercy and compassion, of a world of peace for our children are impossible in our day.

But this is true: it is time for us to wake from sleep, to proclaim God's way of peace and nonviolence. For the night is far gone and the day is at hand.


And sometimes when you spill lemons from your grocery bag, someone else will help you pick them up. Mostly we don't want to harm each other.
