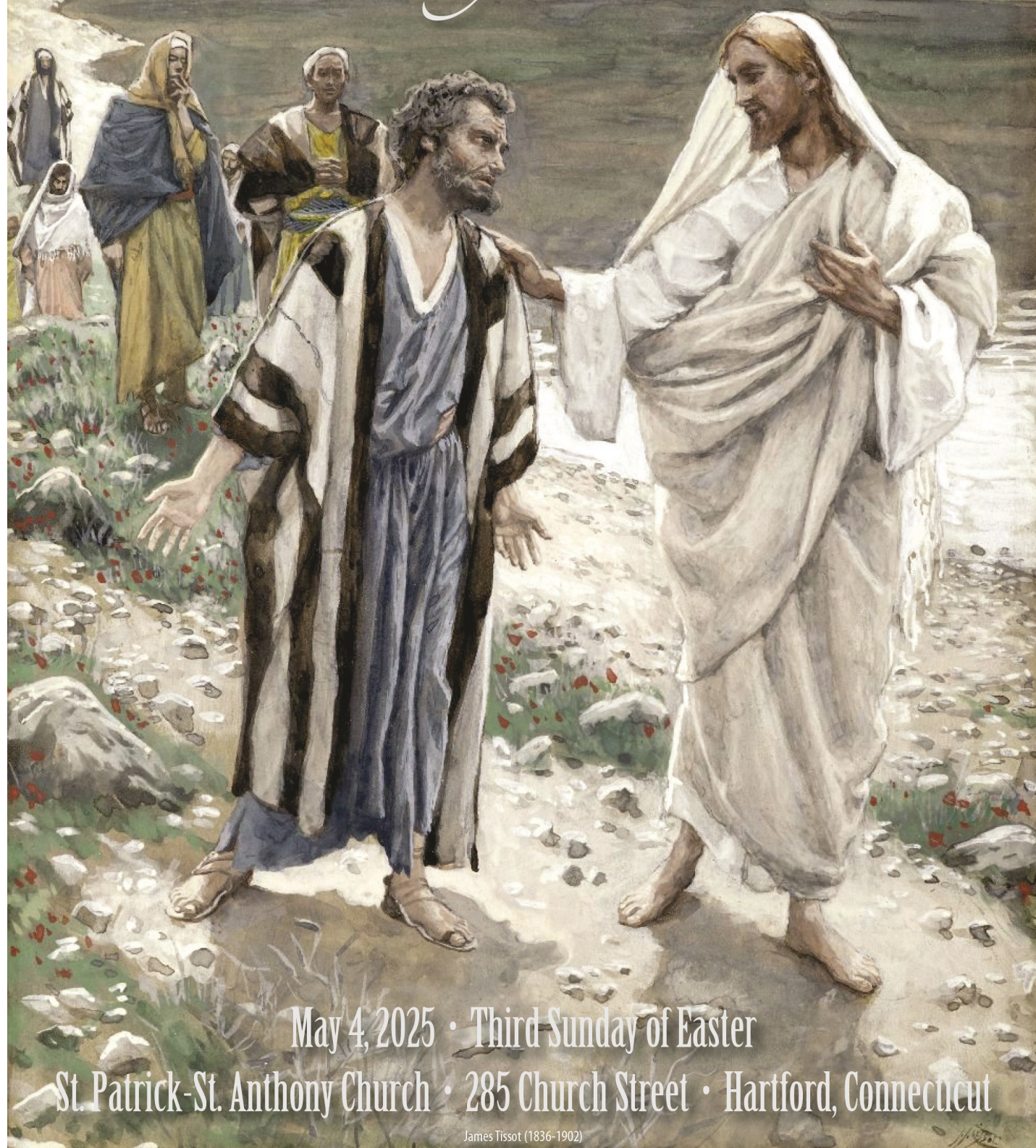

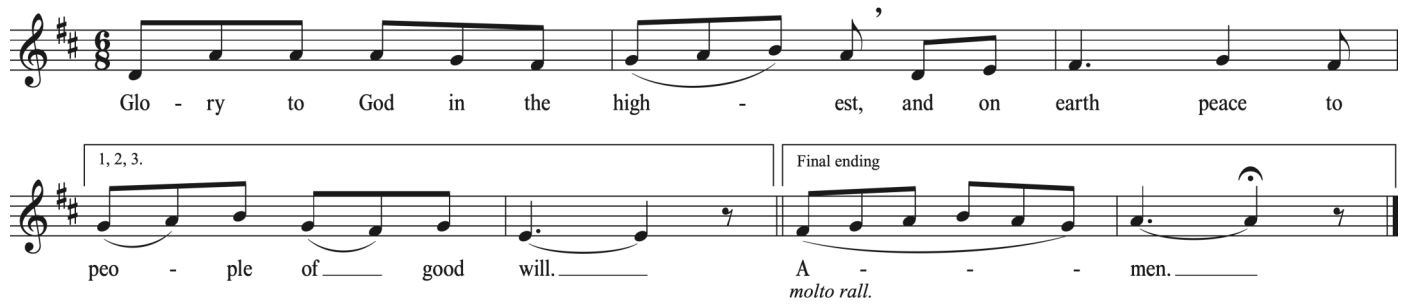

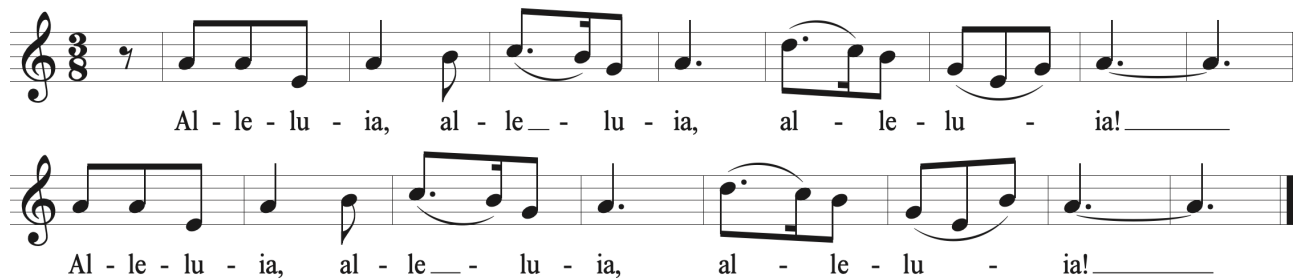

## NICENE CREED
